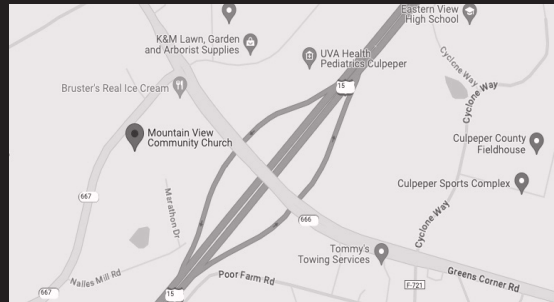

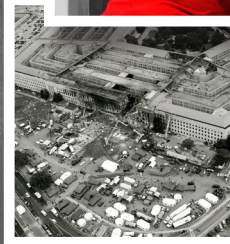
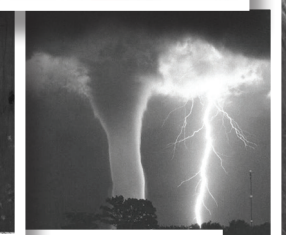

The White House asked CIA, in 2006, to form a coalition of faith-based individuals and organizations who are prepared to respond in the event of a disaster either local or national. This request was the beginning of the Faith Based First Responders (FBFR). The FBFR Training is geared toward the christian community, lay people and clergy alike, crossing denominational boundaries.

The FBFR Training enables people to respond with the love of Christ to their neighbors in times of crisis with understanding, compassion and love. Insight into the grieving process brings practical guidance for personal tragedies that arise on a daily basis as well as those with a national impact.

Utilizing nationally and internationally recognized courses and training the Faith Based First Responders Training will equip and prepare you to respond to crises at home, across the nation and around the world.
